REGISTRATION DEADLINE: June 25, 2010

(Maximum fee for any adult exhibitor = \$15 IF you mail in a PAPER Registration Form. If you register online, EVERY entry will be charged \$1.00 with no upper limit.)

CHECK-IN: Saturday, July 24, 2010

Exhibits will be checked in on Saturday, July 24, 2010 between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Check-in procedure will be sent with exhibitor tags in July. Exhibitor tags must be securely attached to exhibits before arriving at the Fairgrounds.

CHECK-OUT: Monday, August 9, 2010

Exhibits will be checked out after the Fair on Monday, August 9, 2010 between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. **No exhibit will be released at any other time.** A claim check (bottom of exhibitor tag), is required to check out each exhibit.

Any exhibit not claimed by August 13 will be considered abandoned and will become the property of the Ozark Empire Fair to be disposed of as necessary.

REGULATIONS:

1. All entries are governed by the Family Living Rules and Regulations and the rules for this department.
2. Adult exhibitors only (19 years and over). Youth photographers: see Youth Department.

3. **NUMBER OF EXHIBITS:** Exhibitor is limited to a **TOTAL OF 10 (TEN) PHOTOGRAPHS** in this department (special contests, color, black/white and digital combined) with a limit of one (1) photograph per class. **If more than 10 photographs are listed on the Registration, only the first 10 will be accepted.**

4. **SIZE:** Photographs **MUST** be **8"x10" matted to 11"x14"**. **NO FRAME.**
5. **MAT:**
 - a. Use regular photo mat (single or double matted). Other types of mat board tend to fall from display rack. Do **NOT** use foam board.
 - b. Double matted photos (one bottom mat and one top mat) may have a slight overlap of top mat but minimum size of **visible** photograph will be 7½"x9½". Photos will be measured before judging.
 - c. Any color mat will be accepted.
 - d. No decoration allowed on mat.

6. **Professionals** are those who are employed as photographers or teachers of photography or who consistently sell their work. **Non-professionals** are those who have photography as a hobby and make only an occasional sale.
7. Exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor, done within the past two years and not previously shown at the Ozark Empire Fair.
8. **DIGITAL PHOTO COMPETITION**, Division 1506, is intended for photos digitally manipulated in some way with computer programs such as Photoshop, Picture This, Microsoft Photo Editor, etc. **Any image created with the use of computer imaging software should be entered in Division 1506.** (If you took a photo with a digital camera and printed it out without altering it, you may enter that photo in Divisions 1502-1505 OR in Division 1506, but NOT in both.)
9. Exhibitor tags should be securely attached (with string fastened to back of mat) so tag hangs over UPPER left corner of mat.
10. Prize money will be paid to the number of places indicated for each class, if quality merits. Judges may occasionally award additional places but no prize money will be paid for these additional ribbons.
11. The exhibitor and the public are prohibited from touching or handling exhibits in any manner or from helping remove exhibits on release day.
12. Exhibit building will not be open to the public during judging.
13. You worked hard on your entry, and we want everyone to see your work clearly. Small blue, red and white ribbons may be used since large ribbons hide too much of the exhibits. A blue ribbon is first place regardless of the size of the ribbon. If you wish to trade for larger ribbons for your permanent collection, please contact the Exhibits Office after the Fair.
14. In order to have this exhibit of as high quality as possible, the right is reserved to reject all unsuitable exhibits, to determine that all rules and regulations have been followed and that no identification of the exhibitor in any form is displayed during judging.

DIVISION 1501 - SPECIAL CONTESTS

KEEP ON RIDING!
 Prize money: \$5 - \$4 - \$3

One photograph of your favorite ride or means of transportation. May be present or past. May be a vehicle that actually takes you a distance (car, train, buggy, etc.) or maybe just around in circles or repetitions (carnival ride, mechanical bull, rocking horse, etc.). May include other items such as people but the “vehicle” must be the prominent focus of the photo. No digital manipulation, please.

Any photograph with the color **ORANGE** as a major feature. Any subject (an orange flower, a girl in an orange dress, an orange sunset, etc.). No digital manipulation, please.

- a. **Limit 10 (ten) photos per exhibitor** (special contests, color, black/white and digital combined) with a limit of one photograph per class. **If more than 10 photographs are listed on the Registration, only the first 10 will be accepted.**
- b. This division is intended for photos digitally manipulated in some way with computer programs such as Photoshop, Picture This, Microsoft Photo Editor, etc. If you printed a digital camera photo without any alteration or manipulation, you can enter that photo in Divisions 1502-1505 OR in Division 1506, but NOT both. If you digitally altered your photo, you can enter it only in Division 1506.
