Gold Buckle Extravaganza Weekend

July 23-26, 2010



Contest Rules

There will be seven events that 4-H/FFA members are eligible to participate in. You are not required to be an exhibitor to participate in the contests. The six contests in which you may participate are as follows:

1. Scavenger Hunt
2. Stockman's Contest
3. Team Sales Talk
4. Livestock Judging
5. Photography
6. Showmanship

Participants will receive points from the above contest and events only when they turn in or complete the criteria from each event. Points will be awarded for each of the events as pre-determined by a scoring committee. Contestants will be broken by age (as of Jan. 1, 2010) and placed into divisions: Junior- 12 years and under, Intermediate- 13-17 years and Senior- 18 years and over.

Contestants will be eligible to participate as an individual, on a team (4), and for his/her chapter/club. Points which each contestant accumulates as an individual, and/or team (if they choose to participate on a team) will also go toward a total point score for their club/chapter. Teams do not have to be members from the same club/chapter; do note that points gained from the individual will go toward the individual and the club/chapter that he/she belongs to. Teams may be comprised of any age group of individuals who are active in 4-H and/or FFA and from the counties eligible for competition at this event. Only members from Barry, Barton, Bates, Benton, Camden, Cedar, Christian, Dade, Dallas, Douglas, Greene, Hickory, Jasper, Laclede, Lawrence, McDonald, Miller, Morgan, Newton, Polk, Pulaski, St. Clair, Stone, Taney, Vernon, Webster and Wright counties are eligible to compete. Members of FFA Chapters in schools located in the Southwest FFA District are eligible to compete. **Teams will be placed into divisions according to the oldest member's age.** Example, if your team has one junior, two intermediates, and one senior; then your team will be competing in the senior division. As a member of a team, when you compete as an individual in contests such as Photography, Stockman's Contest, Livestock Judging and Scavenger Hunt you will compete in your own age division. Only when competing in Team Sales Talk will you be ranked in the division of your team's oldest member and for overall teams within each division.

Scoring

There are two ways that you may earn points: by competing in contests or attending events. The first is through participation. Each contest or event that you participate in, you will earn 25 points. The second way to receive points is through your individual/team placing. The following are the points possible throughout the weekend:

- Participation (25 pts):
 1. Showmanship (1 time participation only)
 2. Scavenger Hunt
- Stockman's Contest: 25 pts + Placing Points Earned
- Sales Talk Contest: 25 pts + Placing Points Earned
- Livestock Judging: 25 pts + Placing Points Earned
- Photography: 25 pts + Placing Points Earned (Only top 3 individuals in each division)
 - Placing 1st 2nd 3rd
 - Points 10 8 6

Your score earned in each contest will then be ordered from highest to lowest and the highest score will earn first place and second place will have received the next highest score, etc.

Individual points will be distributed in a stair-stepped manner for the Stockman's Contest and Livestock Judging contest. For the Sales Talk competition, each team member will receive the team score based upon the team's overall placing. The points will be distributed in the following manner:

* Only those placing in the top 25 will receive points.

Contest Descriptions

The scavenger hunt must be submitted by noon Sunday to the Livestock Office to receive points.

The Stockman's Contest will be comprised of multiple choice, true/false questions, and identification stations worth a total of 100 points. This is an individual contest; no notes, books, reference materials, or conferring with other contestants will be allowed. Tests will vary according to age divisions. In addition there will be 5 pre-selected tie-breaker questions, unmarked.

Team Sales will be made up of 4 members. Emphasis will be placed on team organization, communication skills, knowledge, and marketing techniques. Order of team presentation will be determined by species of animal used (swine, beef, goats, and sheep). Points will be assessed according to presentation criteria. The following 3 topics should be discussed: pedigree or breed information, performance information, and visual characteristics. Each team will be responsible for selecting an animal to use for competition, it is not to be groomed; but should be clean. Points will be subtracted for those members who do not speak during the presentations. **See complete set of rules on Page 4.**

The Livestock Judging Contest will be comprised of 6 classes: 2 classes of hogs, 2 classes of sheep, 2 classes of beef. One class will be designated for oral reasons.

The Photography Contest allows those who cannot be in attendance during the Extravaganza to participate. You may submit up to four photographs. Photos may be of livestock, landscapes, people, around the farm or ranch, or from the 2009 Gold Buckle Extravaganza weekend or Ozark Empire Fair. Photos will be judged based on quality and content. **Photos may be submitted until 10:00 am on Saturday, July 24, 2010. See page 3 for rules and entry.**

You may receive participation points by showing in Showmanship (you receive points for only one specie) and by completing the Scavenger Hunt.

Awards will be given to the:

- Top 3 Teams in each of the 3 divisions
- Top 2 Clubs and Chapters (will receive cash awards)
- Top 10 Individuals in each of the 3 divisions

Showmanship and Round-Robin Showmanship winners will also be presented with awards. These are stand-alone contests.

The submission deadline is July 1, 2010.

Gold Buckle Extravaganza Photography Contest Rules

The photography contest is open to all 4-H and FFA members. Participants are not required to be present during the Extravaganza weekend to enter the contest. All photographs will be judged and displayed during the Gold Buckle Extravaganza weekend.

- The entrant must have taken the photo during the past year.
- Photos may not be altered or image enhanced in any way.
- Photos may be in black and white or color.
- Photos need to represent one of the following categories.
 1. **Livestock**- The animal should be the dominant portion of the photo and should highlight it at an event or around the farm.
 2. **Landscapes**- Photographs that focus on scenery around the farm or ranch.
 3. **People**- Photograph displays the exhibitor and/or family, friends, or fellow 4-H/FFA member either involved in activities on the farm or ranch or at an event.
 4. **Around the Farm or Ranch**- Photographs which highlights activities and scenes around the farm or ranch.
 5. **2009 Gold Buckle Extravaganza or Ozark Empire Fair**
 6. **Barnyard Babies**- Focus is placed on the young animals around the farm
- Each participant may submit four photographs total.
- Photos may be any size but cannot exceed 8"x10".
- Each photo entered must be mounted neatly on black foam core.
- The entry form must be clipped to the back of the photo. Do not glue or tape.
- Photos become the property of the Ozark Empire Fair for the use in publications and promotions.
- There will be three age divisions: Junior-12 and under, Intermediate- 13-17 and Senior- 18 years and over. Participant's age will be as of January 1, 2010.
- The deadline to have all pictures turned into the Livestock Office is by 10:00 am on Saturday July 24, 2010.
- If you don't plan to attend the event, please send your entries to the address below. Mailed entries must be received by Friday July 23, 2010.

Gold Buckle Extravaganza

Teams Sales Talk

The objective of this contest is to gain a working understanding of performance and pedigree information. Emphasis will be placed on team organization, communication skills, and knowledge and marketing techniques.

- The order of team presentation will be determined by drawing.
- Presentations need to be a minimum of three minutes long, with a maximum of 10 minutes including questions. The presentation will be stopped at the end of 10 minutes.
- Each individual on the team will be expected to speak during the presentation.
- The objective of each team is to sell their animal to the panel of judges.
- The following three topics should be discussed:
 1. Pedigree Information
 2. Performance Information
 3. Visual Characteristics
- Other information may be included in the presentation.
- The judges' questions will not necessarily be limited to the topics listed above.
- Each team will be responsible for selecting an animal to use in the competition.
- Animals are not to be groomed; but should be clean. Animals will be checked when entering the competition area.
- No show halters and no grooming supplies are allowed in the competition area.
- Each team is allowed to enter the competition area only with the animal being marketed.
- Extra promotional items (farm signs, posters, etc), props and incentive gifts to judging panel (key rings, caps, beverages, etc.) are prohibited.
- Folders including pedigrees/registration papers as well as additional information on the animal you are marketing are permitted. *You may supply performance data, pictures, show records, etc. as part of the sales package for the panel of judges.*
- Points will be awarded as follows: Content-10 points, Ability to Communicate-10 points, Team Organization-10 points, Overall Effect-10 points and lastly Knowledge and Response to Questions-10 points.
- Five points will be subtracted if all four team members do not speak.
- Two points will be subtracted for each minute the team presentation goes less than three minutes.
- Each judge will rank the teams based upon points allocated.
- The composite ranking procedure will be used to determine final placing.
- The highest overall effect category score will break ties.
