RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Hay must have been harvested in Missouri in 2010. Indicate cutting date on entry form.
2. Entries may be either conventional, rectangular bales or large packages. No haylage. Note procedures for each.
 - A. Conventional Bales** - One bale selected from the ten bales that were core-sampled for the laboratory analysis. A four-inch block from this bale will be displayed. Only the top ten entries in each class based on laboratory analysis (Relative Feeding Value), will be brought to the Fair for final evaluation.
 - B. Large Packages** - Five bales will be core-sampled for laboratory analysis. Only the top Relative Feeding Value entry in each class will be brought to the Fair for final evaluation due to space limits.
3. Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class. No more than one entry per field, per cutting may be made.
4. If a preservative has been used on the hay, it must be indicated on the entry form. If not indicated, disqualification will result.
5. Entries will be tested for moisture, crude protein, acid detergent fiber and neutral detergent fiber. Calculations will be made for energy values and Relative Feeding Value.
6. Final placing of each class will be based on the results of the laboratory analysis (60%) and subjective evaluation, texture, odor, purity and color (40%).
7. Entry fee, \$19 to cover laboratory analysis. Checks should be made payable to: Ozark Empire Fair. Entry fee must accompany the entry form and is non-refundable.
8. **Entry deadline is July 10, 2010.** Entry forms are available at and must be returned to your nearest University of Missouri Extension Center.
9. Sampling of the hay will be done by the University of Missouri Extension staff.
10. Exhibitors with the top RFV entries will be notified by phone if their entries are to be brought to the Ozark Empire Fair on August 1 for final evaluation. All samples will become the property of the Ozark Empire Fair.
11. Ribbons and prize money will be mailed to exhibitors after August 31, 2010.
